SERVICES PROVIDED BY BRIXHAM DOES CARE TO PEOPLE OF ALL AGES INCLUDE:-

- **A community room for companionship and low cost refreshments, open Monday to Friday 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. Disabled access to all our facilities is available via a lift operating from the ground floor.**
- **Other facilities include:- coach outings, books on wheels, jig-saw lending, form filling, delivery of talking books to the housebound and a range of groups/activities on offer Monday afternoon to Friday afternoon.**
- **A home visiting service, making over 280 visits each month to people in their own homes who are isolated, housebound or vulnerable.**
